STACY FAMILY GOLF TOURNAMENT

This year's event will be held at BOONE'S TRACE NATIONAL GOLF CLUB. The event will be held on Sunday, September 6, 2020. Tee times will be as specified by the Staco Golf Committee. Dress for the event will be appropriate *golf* attire.

Rules and Regulations:

- 1) Final scores shall be adjusted for handicap using EITHER the participant's current USGA GHIN handicap <u>OR</u> the average of the participant's scores for the first three (3) SFGT events. Such determination shall be by the Golf Committee. Any <u>NEW</u> participant without a GHIN handicap shall have their score adjusted per their "stated" true handicap. All handicaps shall be reviewed and approved by the Golf Committee.
- 2) Men will tee off from the white tees, and the ladies will tee off from the red tees. There will be NO mulligans or "re-tees."
- 3) Due to condition of the Course, a player may retrieve, clean, and replace their ball within one "scorecard" length of the original resting place. Should the original resting place be on "bare ground," a player may move their ball laterally in either direction as needed, to a suitable "sod" hitting surface. In either case, the ball cannot be placed any closer to the hole.
- 4) In order to provide a continuous flow of play, all "out-of-bound" shots, or lost balls, will be played from the nearest point of boundary exit, or last visual sighting, whichever may be relevant. Such points must be agreed to by a majority of other participants in the group, and will incur a <u>one shot penalty.</u>
- 5) Since there are no rakes at the sand bunkers, and a player's ball could land in an awkward, unraked area, the player may retrieve their ball and replace it anywhere in the bunker. However, the ball cannot be placed any closer to the hole.

- 7) A contest for <u>LONGEST DRIVE</u> will be held on hole #6. Any winning drive must come to rest (with at least 50% of the ball) in the fairway. If none of the participating players have a drive resting in the fairway, any prize for "Longest Drive" shall revert to the Golf Committee.
- 8) A contest for <u>CLOSEST TO THE PIN</u> will be held on hole #14. Any winning tee shot must come to rest (with at least 50% of the ball) on the green. If none of the participating players have a tee shot resting on the green, any prize for "Closest to the Pin" shall revert to the Golf Committee.
- 9) <u>NO</u> participant may claim more than one prize, and shall go in the following order:
 - *Championship The First Place prize shall go to the player with the lowest "net" score (after handicap is deducted).
 - *Longest Drive The prize for longest drive shall go to the player who has the longest drive (according to Rule #5), but cannot be the participant who claims the Championship prize.
 - *Closest to the Pin The prize for closest to the pin shall go to the player who has the closest tee shot to the pin (according to Rule #6), but cannot be the participant who claims either the Championship or Longest Drive prize.
 - *Dead Ass Last Trophy A trophy will be presented to the player with the <u>HIGHEST</u> net score (after handicap is deducted). Due to the <u>Severe Nature</u> of this prize, this participant may <u>not</u> claim any other prize listed above, <u>AND</u> must pay for the lunch of all other participants at the <u>GOLD STAR CHILI</u> restaurant in Berea, KY.
- 10) We hope that all participants will enjoy this Fourth Annual
